

CONVERSION OF TEMPERATURES

From	To	
Celsius	Fahrenheit	$t_F/^{\circ}\text{F} = (9/5) t/^{\circ}\text{C} + 32$
	Kelvin	$T/\text{K} = t/^{\circ}\text{C} + 273.15$
	Rankine	$T/^{\circ}\text{R} = (9/5) (t/^{\circ}\text{C} + 273.15)$
Fahrenheit	Celsius	$t/^{\circ}\text{C} = (5/9) [(t_F/^{\circ}\text{F}) - 32]$
	Kelvin	$T/\text{K} = (5/9) [(t_F/^{\circ}\text{F}) - 32] + 273.15$
	Rankine	$T/^{\circ}\text{R} = t_F/^{\circ}\text{F} + 459.67$
Kelvin	Celsius	$t/^{\circ}\text{C} = T/\text{K} - 273.15$
	Rankine	$T/^{\circ}\text{R} = (9/5) T/\text{K}$
Rankine	Fahrenheit	$t_F/^{\circ}\text{F} = T/^{\circ}\text{R} - 459.67$
	Kelvin	$T/\text{K} = (5/9) T/^{\circ}\text{R}$

Definition of symbols:

T = thermodynamic (absolute) temperature

t = Celsius temperature (the symbol θ is also used for Celsius temperature)

t_F = Fahrenheit temperature
